





Philosophy

In this blue house, where the source constantly sings, we prefer, as you certainly do too, the song of the birds to the noise of car engines. Hence, after a brief stop for dropping your baggage, vehicles are invited to return to the parking lot besides the main house.

What joy « to be mounting to one's lodging on foot » getting one's legs into shape after a long voyage, and finding oneself in a calm and secure place for all ... in the realm of Queen Nature where « you walk as prince and princess»

If needed, the wheelbarrow taxi is at your disposal for getting your belongings to teepee, caravans and Bergerie Guest House 300 m up the hill, comfortable nests wrapped in unspoilt nature. And if your legs call for a break: bicycles, poneys and donkeys are available for accompanying your ventures in the lush surroundings.

LA MAISON BLEUE

Restaurated by our own hands since 2000, we have committed to the highest possible standards of nature (stone, lime...), and also for its inhabitants (Max Hallevar duvet covers, organic produce&)

Energy is of course likewise produced by solar panels, a wood and pellet stove. Being in such a pro-natural environment, you will make us happy by (as you are probably used to) keeping your use of water, electricity, wood and pellets to the beautiful necessary.

ATTENTION

We are not a restaurant, a tavern, much less a hotel!

It is important to be clear about this, since it has occurred - to our great surprise - that guests arriving in snow white costumes, high heel stilettos and luxury baggage complained about (the rare) spiderwebs in their window's corner, that the "lawn" was not trimmed (we are speaking of our horse paddocks), or that they were even horse droppings on the same !!!

Such saddens us no less than the irritated guest, since our prime interest is before all to offer pleasure and upliftment, to make accessible the grandiose nature surrounding us, and to share our "style of

life". This said, let us emphasize:

the Saint Pierre Farm is first of all A FARM

- with dust, sometimes mud, with animals and insects coming with them, with cocks greeting the morning sun, peacocks chanting, donkeys and horses expressing their temperament, in short :

a place for true Lovers of Nature!!

THE HORSES AND PONEYS

For beginners and advanced riders alike, we put security first. This begins with the attitude to our animals!

In fact, instead of renting out horses for a season (as is commonplace) we keep our horses throughout the entire year ... and yes, we treat, feed and love them 12 months of the year, instead of simply getting them for 3 months of activities.

This may appear costly and incoherent from a perspective of profit, but it is the price to pay for truly knowing each member of the "gang".

Hence, we know everything about their character, their place in the hierarchy, their ways of reacting to this or that situation... which shows especially in moments of a new rider's first mount and deciding onn their position in a group on an expedition.

Highly sensible to soft methods, natural horseriding and ethology, cravaches are ruled out, as well as spurs and kicking heels into bellies. We prefer communication through voice and the senses.

Also, we are not a fast track service provider! At your arrival at the farm for a horseride, we first invite you for getting your mount from the paddock, guide it to the bar, brush it, arrange steps, clean its hoofs, saddle it ... so much opportunity for getting to know one another and build trust (this approach requires that you arrive well on time).

Also, many of our horses go without horseshoes, and we opt more and more for saddles without saddletrees, tailored materials ... and as they do not live in boxes, summer nor winter, they are all out on the paddock as a group as in nature.

For joyful excursions there is nothing better but happy horses!!

THE BIRDS

As all observers of animal protection laws (by the League of Protection of Birds) we provide: nature books, binoculars, birding maps& so you may observe our beautiful nature and all its semi-mediterrenean and -alpine fauna to the fullest. Vultures, Red Beaked Craves, Sitelles, Geais, Buses and other birds of prey are often to be seen.

ORGANIC AGRICULTURE

A small neat organic garden returns to the light each spring. Carina, the gardener, is aided by children and volunteers, seeds, plants, waters, trims, cleans and harvests

... but attention, here the Earth is hard, poor and often stony. It requires particular attention, especially since we follow organic farming principles (biodynamics, plant assortment, ...) without any use of products or treatments but our loving care.

Due to our many activities with horses, children etc., our harvests are rather late (tomatos at the end of August) and little significant (though delicious).

If you are a gardening enthusiast, your counsel, ideas and contributions are welcome.

ATTITUDE TO THE ANIMALS

In our place, animals are of course treated with care and respect, but it is good to emphasize it and to ask everyone to act the same, since we have experienced unpleasing moments: ducks and pigs attacked with stones, strangled chicken and rabbits, hurt poneys ... thank you for sensibilizing your children to this IMPORTANT issue.

THE DOGS

A good number of our animals living in liberty ... we do welcome our friends the dogs, but always held on a leash and under your surveillance.

Also - since we host a grand number of children - the canine races best known for moments of aggression - are not welcome!

Finally, we prefer to keep our dog friends from the living quarters (for respecting hygiene, children and upcoming guests). Thank you for also carrying **up to date vaccination papers** with you.

CIGARETTES

For everybody to benefit from the fresh air of the countryside and not disturb the young(est) ones, we ask smokers not to smoke in the highly frequented spaces (inside and outside).

Suggestion: Why not offer yourself a small promenade for a discreet smoke while stretching your legs?

SHOPPING

You are certainly relieved to be far from the tumult of cities for a while, and you are safe - since here you find zero boutique!

For "The Big"

Ground Floor: Large common room with a wood stove, composed of a kitchen, dining room, party or activities, opening on a grand terrace to the sunny south, shower room / toilet and one room with a 160cm bed.

Upper Floor: 1 open sleeping space with 6 double bunk beds and a room space with a 160cm bed.

For "The Small"

Ground Floor: A fully equipped open kitchen connected at dining room / living room, a large shower room / toilet.

Upper Floor: a room space with a 2-person bed, and another with a 2-person bed and a bunk bed for 2 children.














The "Red Wagon"

A super ecological wagon ... painted in organic colors, acacia wood, double windows and green roof for thermic and sound insulation. To the East: a splendid view of the valley, and from the bed facing West magnificent sunsets over the medival village of Bargème, the lake and its swans, chicken to the left, donkeys to the right, truly "immersed in the countryside"... in spring with the nightly chanting of frogs.

Equipped with a 140cm bed, a small bed for children under 10 years of age, a shower room and dry toilet, a table, fridge, stove and sink.



The "Orange Wagon"

A spacious family wagon with a panoramic view to the east - on the sunrise and the "Roof of the Var", on the farm and the southern valley, the Brouis Mountain Range to the north the castle of Bargème to the west ... all this inmidst the beautiful land-scape of paddocks and horses: detention guaranteed! Close to the shared kitchen and sanitaries. For families a bed of 140 x 190 and 2 beds for children under 10 years of age, a dry toilet space, a fridge, small stove and water boiler.





The "Rose Wagon"

A very spacious family wagon, entirely built from Douglas Pine, with kitchen corner, 1,20m shower, toilet, full comfort in nature, with a panoramic view on the farm and valley to the south, the Brouis Mountain to the north, the Bargème castle to the west ... inmidst of beautiful paddocks and horses: Detention guaranteed!





The "Violet Wagon"

A wagon for lovers, with a comfort bed with a view on the rising sun, the Lachens Mountain ("toit", "roof" of the Var and departure of parasailers), with a view on the farm and valley to the south, all this inmidst of paddocks and horses: Paradise!





The Yurts



300m from the house and right next to the Tee-Pee camp, our two yurts welcome you with their typical painted doors. Softly enveloped and covered in sheep wool, the offer fully natural and highly efficient insulation.

For better comfort, the floors are tiled, and the interior decoration invites you to dream of the wide spaces of the plains.

The shared sanitary rooms are a stronethrow away (think about bringing electric torches...) and if you wish to eat on site, the fully equipped shared summer kitchen and grand family tables offer all you need.



The Tee-Pees

From June to September, a wonderful view downhill on the farm. You get there on foot, 300 metres from the farm.

A true guesthouse under linen, our tee-pees offer you peace and functionality. You will pass your nights under an authentic Native American tent, but with all your necessary comfort: a "real" 1 or 2 person bed, with excellent sheets, blessed with a typical decoration of bison skin, bow and arrow, flags and feathers.

The sanitaries are just next door!

If you wish, you can prepare your meals in our fully equipped "open summer kitchen" - with fridge, stove, sink - and celebrate your holiday with your family tribe.

For reasons of keeping the full splendour of the fabulous night sky, the camp is only minimally lighted ... please bring your electric torch for moving around at nights.






The Star Cabin

Situated at the very top end of the St Pierre territory, this beautiful "cabin" offers you at daytime a grandiose panorama of the entire valley, and at nights the "entire" sky and its stars.

You also find a thematic decor, documentation of the constellations, the planets, a starry sky map, and not to forget - to be even closer to the stars, a telescope is at your disposition!

The cabin is made of one single room, with a comfortable bed for two, a table, 2 chairs, 2 deck chairs....

The shared camp sanitairies and kitchen are 50 metres downhill.

Hikes with the Donkeys

A multiple-day journey with a donkey as your travel companion. Everybody who has experienced it will tell you: it seems like nothing, but what an adventure and joy!

First, we get to know each other ... we go get our friends from the paddy, we brush them, treat them, prepare them, we learn how to pack them and balance out the grand sacks. Then comes a little introduction to donkey psychology, how to handle them and communicate, finally a short walk to the village - and we are ready for the great departure.

The next morning, the adventure begins! A map in hand, it is like a big game ... here we meet a deer or marmot, there we observe a flock of vultures and then come the river, the ford to cross... finally, in the evening, you arrive at the goal of the day's voyage for a nice camp, in brief - **PURE JOY!!**



Whole body treatment 60 min = 65 € 2 treatments of 1h on a week-end = 120 € 1/2h treatment = 40 €



Also at Moulière you depart on an incredible journey to the centre of the Earth on the impressive VIA SOUTERRATA.






RAFTING, CANYONING, CANOEING, KAYAKING.... at Castellane, the regional capital of water sports at 45 minutes from the farm.






